WHEREAS, the Director of Information Technology has reviewed pricing from three vendors authorized to resell the Veeam Enterprise Software, and

WHEREAS, CDW Government, Inc. 203 N. Milwaukee Avenue, Vernon Hills, IL 60061 - Federal ID 36-4230110, has provided the lowest price for this technology solution, AND

WHEREAS, funds are available for said purchase; NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT
